## Situational Report

**Customers, partners, and employees:** YKHC is here for you and your family. YKHC is making decisions related to COVID-19 based on guidance from the CDC, the State of Alaska and other experts. We are erring on the side of caution and in the best interests of our employees, customers and communities. YKHC is publishing a situational report to provide an update on our COVID-19 response and planning. [Here is this week's report.](#)

### Testing Update

As of 2 p.m. December 4 YKHC has performed 45,052 tests — 38,642 are negative and about 3,810 are pending. Three specimens were rejected by a private lab.

- YKHC offers free COVID-19 testing, without an appointment, at the Bethel drive-thru testing site every Monday through Friday from 2 to 5 p.m. Testing continues by appointment in Bethel, by calling 543-6949, or in villages by calling the local clinic for assistance.

### Positive Case Count

- As of December 3, YKHC has confirmed a total of 2629 positive COVID-19 cases in the YK Delta.
  - 30 of these total cases were residents tested out-of-region or were not infectious while here, but per State reporting protocols, will be counted as YK Delta cases.
  - 36 of these total cases are non-residents, so per State reporting protocols, the official State YK Delta case count will remain at 2,593.

### Recoveries

- An individual who has been *symptomatic* is considered recovered when 10 days have elapsed from when symptoms began, symptoms show improvement, and an additional 3 days have elapsed since their last fever.
- An individual who has been *asymptomatic* is considered recovered 10 days from their last test.
- Of the total 2,629 confirmed positives cases in the YK Delta, 2,280 cases are considered recovered, 335 remain active and 14 are deceased.

  - 405 new cases of COVID-19 in the YK Delta
  - 4 in-region hospitalizations
  - 2 deaths

- To date, YKHC has identified evidence of community based transmission of COVID-19 in: Akiak, Bethel, Chevak, Kongiganak, Kwelthluk, Napaskiak, Quinhagak, Scammon Bay, Toksook Bay and Tuluksak.
- Due to a significant increase in COVID-19 cases across the region, case investigations are on-going to identify whether cases are travel-related, a result of close contact, or a result of community-based transmission.
