Situational Report

Customers, partners, and employees: YKHC is here for you and your family. YKHC is making decisions related to COVID-19 based on guidance from the CDC, the State of Alaska and other experts. We are erring on the side of caution and in the best interests of our employees, customers and communities. YKHC is publishing a situational report to provide an update on our COVID-19 response and planning. [Here is this week's report.](#)

Testing Update

As of 3 p.m. June 18, YKHC has performed 88,428 tests —82,529 are negative and about 36 are pending. Three specimens were rejected by a private lab.

- Effective June 19, YKHC will no longer offer COVID-10 testing at the airport in Bethel. COVID-19 testing is available in Bethel on the first floor of the hospital between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Patients should enter through the main hospital doors (not the emergency room entrance) and indicate they are interested in a COVID test. “Close contacts” and people showing symptoms of COVID-19 can schedule testing by calling 543-6949. In villages, please call your local clinic.

Positive Case Count

- As of June 17, YKHC confirmed a total of 5,367 positive COVID-19 cases in the YK Delta.
 - 49 of these total cases were residents tested out-of-region or were not infectious while here, but per State reporting protocols, will be counted as YK Delta cases.
 - 55 of these total cases are non-residents, so per State reporting protocols, the official State YK Delta case count will remain at 5,316.

Vaccination & Transmission Level Status Update by Sub-Region

- As of June 18, YKHC has vaccinated 14,392 unique individuals throughout the YK Delta.

Recoveries

- An individual who has been *symptomatic* is considered recovered when 10 days have elapsed from when symptoms began, symptoms show improvement, and an additional 3 days have elapsed since their last fever.
- An individual who has been *asymptomatic* is considered recovered 10 days from their last test.
- Of the total 5,367 confirmed positive cases in the YK Delta, 5,309 cases are considered recovered, 33 remain active and 25 are deceased.

- For tests completed and returned between June 12 and June 18, there was a test positivity rate of >1% in the YK Delta.
- YKHC continues to encourage everyone eligible in the YK Delta to get vaccinated. All individuals 12 and older are eligible to receive their COVID-19 vaccination.
