## Situational Report

**Customers, partners, and employees:** YKHC is here for you and your family. YKHC is making decisions related to COVID-19 based on guidance from the CDC, the State of Alaska and other experts. We are erring on the side of caution and in the best interests of our employees, customers and communities. YKHC is publishing a situational report to provide an update on our COVID-19 response and planning. [Here is this week's report.](#)

### Testing Update

As of 2 p.m. July 1, YKHC has performed 89,885 tests — 84,426 are negative and about 89 are pending. Three specimens were rejected by a private lab.

- COVID-19 testing is available in Bethel on the first floor of the hospital between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Patients should enter through the main hospital doors (not the emergency room entrance) and indicate they are interested in a COVID test. “Close contacts” and people showing symptoms of COVID-19 can schedule testing by calling 543-6949. In villages, please call your local clinic.

### Positive Case Count

- As of July 1, YKHC confirmed a total of 5,459 positive COVID-19 cases in the YK Delta.
  - 50 of these total cases were residents tested out-of-region or were not infectious while here, but per State reporting protocols, will be counted as YK Delta cases.
  - 56 of these total cases are non-residents, so per State reporting protocols, the official State YK Delta case count will remain at 5,406.

### Vaccination & Transmission Level Status Update by Sub-Region

- As of July 2, YKHC has vaccinated 14,765 unique individuals throughout the YK Delta.

## Recoveries

- An individual who has been *symptomatic* is considered recovered when 10 days have elapsed from when symptoms began, symptoms show improvement, and an additional 3 days have elapsed since their last fever.
- An individual who has been *asymptomatic* is considered recovered 10 days from their last test.
- Of the total 5,459 confirmed positive cases in the YK Delta, 5,371 cases are considered recovered, 63 remain active and 25 are deceased.

## Situation Report

- For tests completed and returned between June 25 and July 1, there was a test positivity rate of 3% in the YK Delta.
- YKHC continues to encourage everyone eligible in the YK Delta to get vaccinated. All individuals 12 and older are eligible to receive their COVID-19 vaccination.

  - If you know someone who does not have access to the internet, they may call 1-800-478-6599 for assistance in submitting a vaccine application.
- A friendly reminder that YKHC will not be hosting its local government calls each week, but now on a tri-weekly basis. YKHC's next local government call will be Thursday, July 15.
