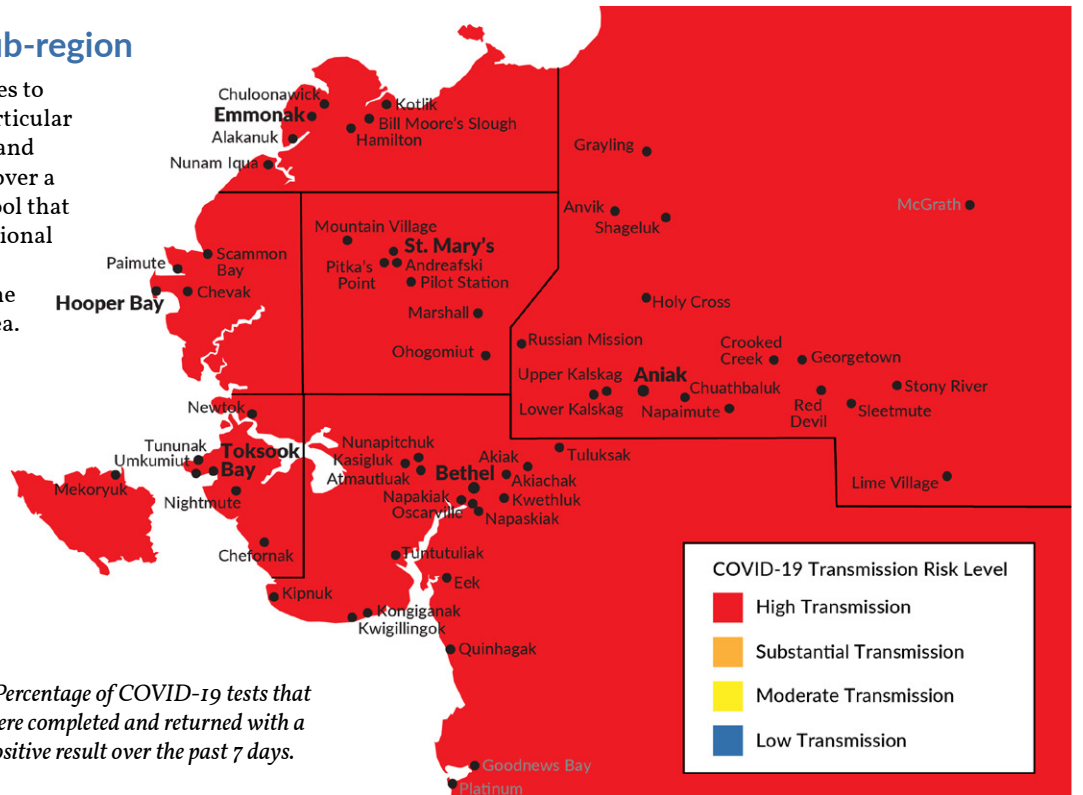

Transmission risk level by sub-region

The CDC recommends using two measures to calculate the risk of transmission in a particular area — (1) the total number of new cases and (2) the percentage of positive tests, both over a period of the past 7 days. This table is a tool that can be used to determine current sub-regional risk level. Sub-regions are defined by the five Sub-Regional Clinic Service areas. The remaining villages fall into the Bethel area.

Testing

Drive-thru COVID-19 testing is available in the parking lot in front of the CHSB, across the street from the hospital, 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., Monday-Saturday. All people who have symptoms of COVID-19 or are close contacts of known positive COVID-19 cases are encouraged to get tested at the mobile testing site.

Walk-in COVID-19 testing is also available in Bethel on the first floor of the hospital between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday-Friday. Patients should enter through the main hospital doors (not the emergency room entrance) and indicate they are interested in a COVID test. "Close contacts" and people showing symptoms of COVID-19 can schedule testing by calling 543-6949. In villages, please call your local clinic.
